Subsection Number:

1. Stockden 'Wills'

With the one known exception of Thomas STOCKDEN (1586) , a copy of whose will I have obtained for Part II of the Stockden History, no wills or notes of administration could be found until that of James (1838) Stockden. James held the tenancy of Mead Farm at Olveston from 1872 until his death in 1900. At one time he was unable to read or write! His photograph and that of his wife and family are reproduced in the 'Photographs' section.

2. Stockden 'Strays'

'Strays' - those Stockdens who married outside of the county in which they were born.

3. The 'Photographs'

The photographs made available to me and which are suitable to be scanned into this work. Comments against each should be clear enough to let you know who they are.

4. The 'Mystery' Stockdens

These are a few details and comments on a number of Stockdens who lived in the 1800's of whom I can not find any further evidence of their origin or births and deaths. These I consider likely to be relations to the Gloucestershire Stockdens but have decided to list them separately.

Of about six other Stockden names I found that lived/were born in the 1800's two at least can be associated with the Congleton, Cheshire, branch in which births appear to be registered from 1752 to 1777. Two deaths registered in Congleton, one in 1842 is with some certainty, Mary Ann (1777) Stockden who was 64 years old at the time of her death, the other was a Sarah Stockden in 1846 who remains unidentified at present. An Alvan Stockden was born at Congleton in 1848 to a Mary Stockden (n.f.i. on either) and in 1866 a Thomas Stockden died at Alcester, Worcestershire. Research will continue on these Stockdens for Part II to be issued later.

5. Armed Forces Service Records from Kew Records Office

Those Stockdens who served in the Army during World War I and the Army and Royal Air Force during World War II.
