Section 1: United Kingdom

**Mary Anne (1813) STIFF**

Mary Anne, daughter of Robert (1789) Stockden, was born 15 August, grew up in Iron Acton and followed her brother to Bath where she was probably in domestic service. When she married Robert Stiff, a collier, (son of Robert Stiff and possible relation to her mother Sarah) she and Robert were living in Princes Buildings, Bath.

**Elizabeth (1826) HARRIS**

Elizabeth, daughter of Robert (1789) Stockden, was born 23 April 1826. She was working as a domestic servant in one of the big houses there, her address being 4 St James Square, Bath, on her marriage certificate. It is possible that she was living at the home of her brother George. She married Sydney George Harris in Bath on 19 June 1860.

Her husband, Sydney George, was thirty years old at the time they married and on the marriage certificate gave his address as Maldon Road, Witham, Essex. His occupation was given as 'clerk in a watchouse' (sic). His father George Harris (deceased) had been a master florist. The first of their two children, a son, was born in London and named Frederick Stockden Harris. In the 1881 census, Frederick, by now a carpenters apprentice, was living at the home of Thomas Morgan at Stapleton, Bristol. Thomas was the husband of Frances Morgan (née Stockden). (Frances was not identified in the 1881 census).

Frederick Stockden Harris, moved to Bristol some years later and married there. He was twenty-one years old when he married Betty Horne who was aged twenty-two years. He was then living at 10 Jamaica Street - Betty was living at 2 Jamaica Street. I found that in the 1881 census, Frederick's name which should read "Frederick 'S' Harris", but the 'S' appears to read as a 'J'.

A second son was born in 1867, William Sydney Harris was born 27 February at Winterbourne in Gloucestershire. His father Sydney George, had died in London in 1867 when Elizabeth was six months pregnant. William Sydney was a carpenter, and on 2 March 1889 he married Ann Summerhill at St Saviours, Bristol. They were then living at 4 Brighton Terrace. Their daughter, Gladys Maud, was born 16 April 1894 at 2 Old King Street, Bristol. Gladys eventually married William Harold Moore on 26 September 1926 at St Saviours, Bristol. In the 1881 census William Sydney was residing at the home of his uncle William Morgan, brother of Thomas Morgan who married Elizabeth's sister Frances in 1846.

**Jane (1827-1907) HOBBS**

Jane had a daughter, Elizabeth, in 1852. She was the daughter of Thomas (1802) Stockden and married Daniel Hobbs (1829-1874) on 14 November 1857 in Clifton. In 1881 the census shows us that Jane was a widow with two sons - twins Edward and Joseph, born 3 February 1867 and a daughter Mary Ann, born 1 May 1870. Their first child was also a daughter, Ann, born in 1857 but died within two years and was

buried on 27 July 1859. Jane died at Rangeworthy on 3 December 1907 aged 80 years. Daniel Hobbs was buried at Rangeworthy on 22 July 1874.

**Ellen (1829) DAVIES**

Ellen, daughter of Robert (1879) Stockden, was born 29 March 1829. She married Isaac Davies, a 33 years old journeyman gardener, on 20 August 1860 in Bath. Like her sisters before her she was a domestic servant, living in Bath, at 16 Northampton Buildings. Isaac, who lived at the same address, had been a witness at Elizabeth Stockden's wedding just two months before. His father, the late Richard Davies, had been an engineer. The other witness was Thomas Morgan, husband of Ellen's sister Frances.

**Caroline (1832-1908) DAVIS**

Caroline, daughter of James (1808) Stockden was, in 1861, working as a cook for Thomas J Ward, a Gentleman JP, of Old Down Farm House, Old Down, Fern Park. Caroline eventually married Daniel Davis on 12 April 1864. Daniel (1842-1926), was born at Littleton-on-Severn, and also worked as a servant at Old Down. A son, Edward Daniel, born 1869, died 31 Oct 1871. In the 1881 census, they had a daughter aged fifteen years named Ada Mary. Daniel was now a grocer in Olveston. Also there was a widow named Elizabeth Davis, who was a grocer, she was born in Shepton Mallett, Somerset, and was probably Daniel's mother.

**Emma (1836-1872) DAVIES**

Emma was the second daughter of James (1808) Stockden. She married James Huland Davies in 1866. Her headstone, in St Mary's churchyard, Olveston, in the family plot (next to her father who had died the previous October) reads as follows : 'Emma, beloved wife of James Huland Davies of Woodhouse, in this parish, who died 8 November 1872 aged 36 years, also of Herbert James, their son, who died 15 November 1871, aged 3 years, also of Maria, their daughter, who died 23 April 1875, aged 5 years; also of Ann, his second wife who died 28 April 1897, aged 55 years, also of the aforesaid James Huland Davies, who died 4 May 1912, aged 74 years'. It is possible that there was a daughter of the second marriage, named Kate. She was aged 4 years in the 1881 census.

**[Author's Note :**

James Davies, son of James Huland Davies and his second wife, Ann, died aged 24 years. His headstone is also close by his fathers in St Mary's churchyard].

**Louisa (1842) HOLLEY / STOCKDEN**

Louisa, daughter of Thomas (1811) Stockden, was born 5 September 1842 and married William Holley on 19 August 1867 in Bath. According to a birth certificate registration, at Walcot (Bath), a child (unnamed) was born on 4 January 1883 to Louisa Stockden (née Stockden), of 4 Pierrepont Place, Bath. The father of the child was a Henry Stockden, a letter carrier. (Henry is as yet an unidentified member of the STOCKDEN Family Tree). Curiously, the baby was registered by a cousin, Elizabeth White of 4 Bell Cottages, Bath. (She could not write and made her mark, an 'x', in the usual way).

**Sarah (1844-1936) PITCHER**

Sarah, daughter of James (1808) Stockden, at 17 years of age followed her

siblings to become an under-nurse in the same big house of the Ward family at Fern Park. At twenty-four years of age she married Arthur Pitcher (1845-15 Jan 1912) on 21 December 1867 at the Olveston Methodist Church. Sarah died at 15 Normanton Road, Clifton and was buried at St Mary's church Olveston on 14 March 1936 aged ninety-two years. Arthur was a 22 years old carpenter at the time of their wedding. His father Henry, was also a carpenter. Sarah and Arthur had at least two children and both were baptised into the Wesleyan Methodist church at Olveston; Rowland Arthur Pitcher, born 2 August 1869 baptised on 8 September 1869 and Florence Jane born 27 June 1871 and baptised on 14 August 1871. All four in this family were found in the 1881 census.

### **Bethia (1848) AMOS**

Bethia, daughter of George (1823) Stockden, was baptised on 13 February 1848. When Bethia was twenty years old in 1868 she married Samuel Amos aged twenty-one years. Bethia's son Thomas Amos was born in 1868 and was with his grandparents when the 1871 census was taken. Neither Bethia nor Samuel could be found living in Gloucestershire in the 1881 census.

### **Eliza (1850) BLAKE**

Eliza, daughter of William (1825) Stockden, was married on 18 August 1868 to James Blake, a labourer, son of Philip Blake, a boatman. The wedding took place at the Cardiff Register Office. Her father William, was at this time, a stoker at the Soapworks at Maindy. Nothing more is known of Eliza other than her brother Thomas (1858) Stockden was lodging with her at the time of the 1881 census..

[**Author's Note:** Elizabeth Jane Stockden was born at Merthyr Tydfil in 1850 and apparently died there in 1853 according to St Catherine House records. Thomas Stockden lived in the Blake household at the 1881 census, thus confirming this 'Eliza' as his sister.]

### **Jane (1851-1927) WATKINS**

Jane, daughter of James (1808) Stockden, was born 3 November 1851 and died on 27 April 1927. She was aged nine at the time of the 1861 census and was described as a 'laundress' living at home in the 1871 census. She married Luke Watkins on 22 May 1875. Their daughter Lily Maria died in 1917 at the age of forty-one years and is buried in St Mary's churchyard at Olveston. Jane also had a son before her marriage, named Philip, born in 1869, he died on 24 December that year. Lily Maria was also an unmarried mother.

### **[Author's Note :**

Luke's father was Robert Watkins, who died 30 November 1889, aged eighty years : his wife Emma, (1811-7 Jan 1892) aged eighty years; their headstone is in St Mary's churchyard not far from the Stockden family plot. Emma Watkins (née Merrett, was Jane's aunt, therefore Luke was her cousin).]

### **Mary Jane (1851) GUY**

Mary Jane was the daughter of Thomas (1821) Stockden. Baptised on 19 January 1852 she was probably born in December 1851. She married Edward Guy on 25 December 1876 at Holy Trinity parish church, Stapleton, Bristol. In the 1881 census they had a daughter aged two years, named Nellie. Edward came from Downend, near Bristol and is probably the son of widow Emily Guy aged forty-nine years, who scraped a living

as a laundress. Edward had siblings John, aged twenty-six; Emily, aged seventeen and William aged fifteen years. All three of Emily's sons were described as 'stonecutters'.

**Charlotte (1856) DEWICK**

Charlotte, daughter of Thomas (1811) Stockden, was born 17 August 1856. On 30 January 1882, Charlotte, a dressmaker, had a baby boy named Ernest, who was born at 16 Widcombe Parade, Bath. Little Ernest's death was recorded later in the year at Clutton, near Bath. Charlotte moved to Derby eventually where she was married in 1900 to a man named Dewick.

**Emily (1858) STOCKDEN**

Emily, daughter of Thomas (1821) Stockden, was born and baptised in Stapleton. Whilst she was living with her parents, she had three children who were also baptised at Holy Trinity parish church, Stapleton.. Her first child was Lilian May (1879) (see 'Family of' :). Her second child, William (1883), went to Wales by 1919 (see 'Family of' :). Sadly nothing is known after the 1891 census of what happened to Emily, or her third child namely, Lewis Gilbert who, although born in 1889, was not baptised until 25 April 1893 (the entry has a date of 24 February 1890 beside it, the meaning of which is not understood) at Trinity Parish Church, Stapleton. (see updates.)

**Else Maria (1867-1942) HASKINS**

Else (Elsie) Maria, daughter of James (1838) Stockden, was born on 6 April and was baptised into the Wesleyan Methodist church in Olveston on 9 May 1867. She married 'Frank' William Haskins 10 August 1893 at St Mary's Church, Olveston. She died in Olveston and was buried at the St Mary's parish church on 27 June 1942. Her husband, Francis William, was a gardener aged twenty-six, and his father John was a market gardener (florist and gardener in the 1881 census) who's family lived at 17 Olveston Green. Frank died and was buried also in St Mary's on 2 November 1940 aged seventy-two years. Else and Frank's family created the following 'tree':

### **Ellen (1870) DAVEY**

Ellen, daughter of James (1838) Stockden and known as Nell, was born 30 March 1870 and was baptised into the Wesleyan Methodist church 4 May 1870. She was a thirty-one years old nurse when she married William Sidney Davey, a thirty-five years old 'jobmaster', on 30 July 1901 at the Olveston Parish church. William's father was Thomas Davey (deceased). They had three children :

Ella (? ); Basil (? ) and Sybil (? -1950 ) Sybil had a daughter - Ann

### **Mary (1872-1961) NEWTON**

Mary, daughter of James (1838) Stockden, was apparently known as 'Mamie' and at the age of twenty was a domestic servant nurse at 3 Caledonia Place, Clifton. She married Cyril Hubert Newton on 29 October 1894 at St Mary's, Olveston.

In 1922 with her young son Claude, Mary followed Cyril to New Zealand, where he had emigrated to in 1912/13. Mary made one return trip to England in 1935 visiting her children (who did not emigrate with her) and two sisters Blanche and Emily, but decided to return to New Zealand where she eventually died on 23 December 1961. Cyril (usually known as 'Sid') was born on 6 August 1872 and was a twenty-two years old baker, (following in the footsteps of his father Edward Henry Newton) when he married Mary. He was buried 16 May 1957 at Ashburton in New Zealand. Their four children - all born in the London area :

Hilda Mary (1895-1944) d September (killed by V1 flying bomb)  
married Sidney Pilborough;

Douglas Henry (1896-c 1957 ?) married Daisy Hanks;

Kathleen Irene (1898-1986) b 28 August - died in August. Known as 'Kath' she married Harry Davey:

Claude married Janet Steele (d 1969). Their two children :

### **Emily Sarah (1873-1968) BARTHOLOMEW**

Emily Sarah, daughter of James (1838) Stockden, married John C Bartholomew at

West Ham, London in 1912. She died at Hastings in 1968 at the age of ninety-five years. Apparently she once had a shop in Bexhill. She regularly visited her sisters Kate and Beattie in Henbury during her old age, however, they failed to get on well together and usually fell out after a week! There were no children of this marriage.

**Kate (1874-1961) STEVENS**

Kate, daughter of James (1838) Stockden, was born on 9 July and was baptised in the Wesleyan Chapel, Olveston. On 31 October 1899 at St Mary's church, Olveston, she married Joseph William Stevens, a twenty-five years old postman from Henbury, whose father Henry was a gardener. Kate was eighty-seven years old when she died in 1961; Joseph predeceased her in 1946. There were three children :

Marjorie (1901-1994) married Charles Hellen (1893-1974).

Their one son:

David (1933) married Doris Simmons (1934).

They have two daughters :

Susan (1958) married Andrew Scott (1960) and

Linda (1961) married Nick Morgan (1962) have a son

Maurice (1903-1988) married Margaret Palmer (1911-1988), on 26 August 1939 at St Albans Church, Westbury Park, Bristol. Their children (twins) :

Pauline (1940) born in October, married on 8 July 1967

Robert Stevenson and they have two children :

Paul (1968) and

Heather (1970).

Robert (1940) has remained a bachelor;

Violet (? ) who married firstly the Reverend Wynn, who died in 1945, married secondly to George Moncrieft.

**Edith (1875) PASSINGHAM**

Edith (1875), also named as Ada in the 1881 census was the first of John (1853) Stockden's two daughters. She eventually married in 1916 to a Canadian, Herbert Edgar Passingham, a ship's chief steward. Both gave their address as Cardiff Castle Hotel, George Street, where Edith may have worked or it could be just a residential address for the duration prior to the marriage. The marriage certificate gives no detail of her profession. Edith gave her age as thirty-six years to the registrar but she was actually forty-one years old at the time of her marriage. On her marriage certificate Edith's father was listed as 'Foreman at a Fuel Factory'.

**Bessie (1876) NICHOLLS**

Bessie, daughter of George (1834) Stockden, married Jim Nicholls, a twenty-eight years old railway engine-driver, on 26 December 1898 at St Mary's Church, Olveston. Jim, who came from Merthyr Dyfan, near Barry, served in South Africa during the Boer War and they both emigrated to South Africa about 1904. Before they emigrated, Bessie's brother Thomas George (1867) Stockden, his wife Ellen and their first two children (Nellie May and Wilfred George) lived for a while with her in Gaen Street, Barry, having moved there sometime after the birth of Wilfred George in 1899 (probably to keep Bessie company while Jim was in South Africa). I am

guessing that Jim Nicholls was a friend of both the brothers, Thomas George and James (1866) Stockden during his few years in Barry and through them he met their sister Bessie.

### **Rosina (1876-1954) TELFORD**

Rosina, daughter of John (1853) Stockden, was born in Cardiff, the third child and second daughter of John and Ellen Stockden. According to St Caths her birth was registered in the last quarter of 1876. However, a descendent of Rosina has her birth down as 7 May 1877, and her death on 2 September. On 16 April 1900 she married James Henry Telford (16 Sep 1877) at St John the Baptist church in Cardiff. James, her husband, died 8 January 1930. Both died in Port Talbot, to where they had moved between 1903 and early 1905. Their children :

Robert John (1900-1995) b 30 December - d 4 February at Bath, Somerset, married Gwendoline Allen (27 Jun 1908), on 3 September 1931 at Port Talbot. Their children :

Alan John (1934-1994) b 23 July - d 5 May; married Audrey Trotter and they had three children:

Edith Olive (1902-1902) d 11 October and was buried 18 October at Cardiff.

Frank Stockden (1905-1978) b 29 April at Port Talbot - d 14 April at Bridgend. He married Selina Ellen Pitman (22 Feb 1909-18

Dec 1967) on 3 October 1936 at Port Talbot. Their children

Jean Margaret (1940) b 16 December at Neath Hospital, married Brian Davies (12 Dec 1938) on 10 March 1962 at Port Talbot. They emigrated to Australia in 1966. Their children :

Carl (1969) b 8 August in Brisbane and

Mark (1970) b 18 December also in Brisbane.

Joyce Helen (1942-1989) b 29 August at Neath Hospital and d 3 February at Cardiff Heath Hospital, married Norman Henry Perks (5 Jun 1942) of Bargoed, on 2 October 1965 at Port Talbot.

Russell Stuart (1967) b 8 February at Blaina Hospital, married Linda Tudor (née Harvey) on 14 August 1991 at Bridgend. They have a daughter

Rosina Helen (1907-1977) b 17 November 1907- d 13 April 1977 at Port Talbot, married Sidney Reginald Fukes on 24 September 1932. Their children :

Marian Rose (1935) b 15 October at Port Talbot married David Lewis (30 Jun 1932) on 4 August 1962. They have one daughter



Kay (1964) b 24 April at Port Talbot.

**Emma (1877) YOUNG**

Emma, daughter of Uriah (1843) Stockden, was born in Thornbury, Gloucestershire and married Frank Young at Thornbury in late 1901. They emigrated to Canada soon after. Frank apparently became a Montreal docks pilot. They had two children : Mona and Henry.

**Lilian May (1880) NASH**

Lilian May, daughter of Emily (1858) Stockden, eventually became a prison wardress in Cheetham, Prestwich, north Manchester, where in 1914, she had a son named Thomas Norman Stockden. In 1920, she married Albert E Nash in Kings Norton, Birmingham.

**Beatrice Jane (1883) LEWIS**

Beatrice Jane, daughter of James (1838) Stockden, married Matthew Henry (Harry) Lewis on 10 January 1906 at St Mary's Church, Olveston. She was twenty-one and her husband Matthew was a twenty-eight years old stationmaster of Peterchurch, Herefordshire. His father, also named Matthew was a farm bailiff. Harry died in 1930. They had one child, Jack, who died in 1988, and he had married Olive who died in 1967. Jack married secondly, in 1969 to Madge (l.n.u.) - who survived him. Jack and Olive's two sons were Roger and David. (Beattie lived with Maurice and Margaret Stevens for a while during WWII. She later bought a bungalow in Henbury to be near her sister Kate.)

**Beatrice (1893-1979) PAYNE**

Beatrice, daughter of William (1873) Stockden, was born 11 July and died 15 January 1979 aged eighty-six years. She married Wilfred Payne at Merthyr Tydfil in 1917. Their children :-

Leslie (1922-1991) b 8 March - d 29 March. He married Betty Boulton 23 December 1950 at St Pauls, Foleshill, Coventry and had no issue.

Audrey (1924-1967) b 4 October and d 26 July.

Betty (1926-1986) b 11 December and d 3 August.

Ivor (1929-1980) b 28 March and d 13 May. Married Winifred Salisbury on 27 March 1951 at Worcester. Their three children :

Judith (1952) b 24 June married Paul Robert Bryan on 4 September 1971. They have two children :

### **Violet (1896-1973) THOMAS**

Violet, daughter of William (1873) Stockden, was b 2 April and d 6 September 1973. She married Percy Thomas in 1924 at Pontypool. Their three children :

Eric (1929-1984) b 25 September and d 17 April. He married Thelma Mary Baxter, (17 Nov 1929) on 23 May 1952 at Pontypool. As a widow, Thelma Mary married Geoffrey Herbert Partis, widower of Nancy Partis (née Stockden)

The children of Eric and Thelma are :

### **Nellie May (1897-1975) LEE**

Nellie May, daughter of Thomas George (1867) Stockden, was b 16 August 1897 and d 19 November 1975. She married in 1920, to Charles Lee, (17 Jul 1888-05 Aug 1966), at Barry, South Wales. Charles Lee was a railway worker and the family eventually moved to Bentley Heath, near Solihull in the Midlands. Charles served in a mortar battalion during WWI. The terrible time he had in the trenches turned his hair white overnight!.

**Eva (1898-1994) JONES**

Eva, daughter of William (1873) Stockden, was born 28 January 1898 and died 11 December 1994, married J. Haydn Jones in 1924 at Pontypool. Their two sons :

[ **Author'sNote:** I should perhaps include **Ruth Stockden** in this section. Ruth was born Ruth Dayman in 1860. Her mother was Alice Dayman who later married George (1834) Stockden. However, it would appear from the census records of 1861 that little Ruth lived with her mothers relatives during her early years but in the 1871 census she is recorded as 'Ruth Dayman', a 12 years old servant in the home of James (1838) Stockden, brother of her step-father George Stockden. The next trace of her I found was when she gave birth to a son, Frederick Stockden in 1878 at the Wakefield Union Workhouse, in Yorkshire. At this time she was known as 'Ruth Stockden'. This was the name that also appeared on her marriage certificate when she later married Thomas Pugh in 1880. The certificate also named her 'father' as George Stockden of Olveston, Gloucestershire. Frederick was presumably adopted by Thomas Pugh as the 1881 census record shows him as Frederick Pugh.]
